

## ŚRĪ MAHĀLAKŞMYAŞŢAKAM

## Hymn to Mahālakshmī

Śrī gurubhyo namaḥ, Śrī lābh śrī śubh śrī gaṇeśāya namaḥ. Mahālaksmyastakaṁ stotram.

Salutations to the Guru; salutations to Ganesha, the auspicious one.

 Namaste'stu mahāmāye śrīpīṭhe surapūjite, Śaṅkha-cakra-gadā-haste mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Salutations to you, Mahāmāyā, abode of fortune, worshipped by gods, wielder of conch and mace, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

2. Namaste garuḍārūḍhe kolāsura-bhayankari, Sarva-pāpa-hare devi mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Salutations, O rider of Garuda, terror of the demon Kola, remover of sins, beloved goddess, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

3. Sarvajñe sarvavarade sarva-dusta-bhayankari, Sarva-duhkha-hare devi mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Knower of all, giver of all boons, a terror to the wicked, remover of all sorrows, beloved goddess, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

4. Siddhi-buddhi-prade devi bhukti-mukti-pradāyini, Mantra-mūrte sadā devi mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Bestower of intelligence and success, O goddess, bestower of worldly enjoyment and liberation, with the mantra always as your form, goddess Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

5. Ādyanta-rahite devi ādyaśakti maheśvari, Yogaje yogasambhūte mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Without beginning or end, O goddess, primordial energy, great mistress born of yoga, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

6. Sthūla-sūkṣma-maharaudre mahaśakti mahodare, Mahā-pāpa-hare devi mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

In the form of the gross and subtle bodies, Rudra's Shakti, source of all, remover of great sins, beloved goddess, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

7. Padmāsana-sthite devi parabrahma-svarūpiņi, Parameśi jagan-mātar mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Seated on a lotus, O goddess, true Self of the supreme Brahman, O supreme mistress, universal mother, Mahā-lakshmī, obeisance to you.

8. Śvetāmbaradhare devi nānālankāra-bhūṣite, Jagat-sthite jagan-mātar mahālakṣmi namo'stute.

Clad in white apparel, O goddess, bedecked with a variety of jewels, supporter of the universe, universal mother, Mahālakshmī, obeisance to you.

9. Mahālakṣmyaṣṭakaṁ stotraṁ yaḥ paṭhed bhaktimān naraḥ, Sarva-siddhim avāpnoti rājyaṁ prāpnoti sarvadā.

This hymn to the great goddess of wealth, if read with devotion, will bestow all success, will grant all worldly position.

> 10. Eka-kāle paṭhen nityam mahā-pāpa-vināśanam, Dvi-kālam yaḥ paṭhen nityam dhana-dhānya-samanvitaḥ.

If always read once a day, great sins will be destroyed. If always read twice a day, wealth and prosperity will ensue.

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11. Tri-kālam yaḥ paṭhen nityam mahāśatru-vināśanam, Mahālakṣmīr bhaven nityam prasannā varadā śubhā.

If always read three times a day, the great enemy (ego) will be destroyed. Mahālakshmī will be ever pleased with that auspicious one.

Sadgurunāth Mahārāj kī Jay! Hail the true Guru!

## LAKSHMI

Lakshmi is the goddess of light, beauty, good fortune and wealth. Being the consort of Vishnu, the preserving principle, Lakshmi also signifies love and grace. While Lakshmi is generally worshiped to achieve success, she does not reside long with anyone who is lazy or desires her only as wealth. She is the power of diversity and also the mother of desire (Kama). Though many deities are associated with the purity of the lotus, Lakshmi above all represents this purity. As the consort of Vishnu, she appears with him in every one of his incarnations, mainly as Radha to Krishna and as Sita to Ram.
